KINDERGARTEN ORIENTATION

Kindergarten Orientation commences next Tuesday and I am looking forward to meeting our new 2021 students. If you have not already enrolled your child for Kindergarten next year, then I urge you to contact the school immediately to ensure they do not miss out on this most important transition program.

END OF YEAR ACTIVITIES

Information is being sent home soon about your child's end of year activity. With the relaxation of Covid-19 restrictions, each stage will be leaving school for a day of fun at a recreational venue. To ensure that every student has the opportunity to attend, there will be no cost to parents, with the school paying for every child.

Covid-19 Safety Plans have been received from every venue to ensure health and safety measures are in place to maintain the health and wellbeing of students and staff while participating in activities.

Please note that as part of the risk management plans being developed by the school:

- students who are unwell and displaying flu like symptoms will not be able to attend
- parents of students who develop flu like symptoms during the excursion will be contacted so arrangements can be made for their child to be collected from the venue.

PARTIAL ABSENCES

Partial absences reflect any time a child is absent from school for part of the school day. This means arriving at school after 8.55am or leaving before 3.00pm. It is a legal requirement for schools to record partial absences and they are included in student reports. Please consider carefully before coming to school to take your children early because of appointments, as any partial absence, regardless of the reason, is recorded and submitted to the Home School Liaison officer for monitoring.

2021 ENROLMENT NUMBERS

A reminder to all parents of the importance of the school having accurate enrolment numbers for the beginning of the 2021 school year. Having this information helps to ensure that classes are formed as quickly as possible when students return in January. If your child is in Kindergarten to Year 5 and will be leaving the school or returning after Friday 29 January, please inform the school by completing and returning the note that was recently sent home.

SUN SAFETY

It is a well established school policy that students without a hat need to stay under the shelters during recess and lunch. This policy applies all throughout the year. Students must bring a school hat with them each day they come to school so they can access all play areas. Could I ask that you also apply sunscreen daily to your child before sending them to school.
