SICK STUDENTS AND COVID-19 TESTING

Last Thursday I sent a note home outlining new practices to ensure our students, staff and community stay safe. I would like to reinforce with you some of the procedures pertaining to sick children and the importance of keeping them at home until they are fully recovered.

If a student falls ill while at school, the department's current first aid procedures apply, including contacting the student's parent or carer or emergency contact, to collect the student. Please assist us by ensuring that your emergency contacts are up to date.

Please do not send your child to school if they are unwell. This includes a runny nose, high temperature, coughing, sneezing, gastro or vomiting. We will contact you and ask you to pick your child up if they are sick. It is unfair on your child, other students and the staff if you ignore this advice. Let's look after each other and keep us all healthy and safe!

As per the new guidelines, staff and students with these symptoms are required to get a COVID-19 test. They will not be able to return to school until they have received a negative test result and their symptoms have resolved. Confirmation of the negative COVID-19 test result must be received and sighted by the school. Negative test results are communicated by NSW Health through SMS notifications.

Parents and carers are requested to send a copy of the result notification to the school's email smithfielw-p.school@det.nsw.edu.au Don't forget to include your child's full name, date of birth and class.

Stay safe everyone, take care. This is a difficult time for everyone. We are following mandatory guidelines. Please be mindful of this when speaking with our staff members. Let's be kind and respectful as we work through this together.

KINDERGARTEN ENROLMENTS 2021

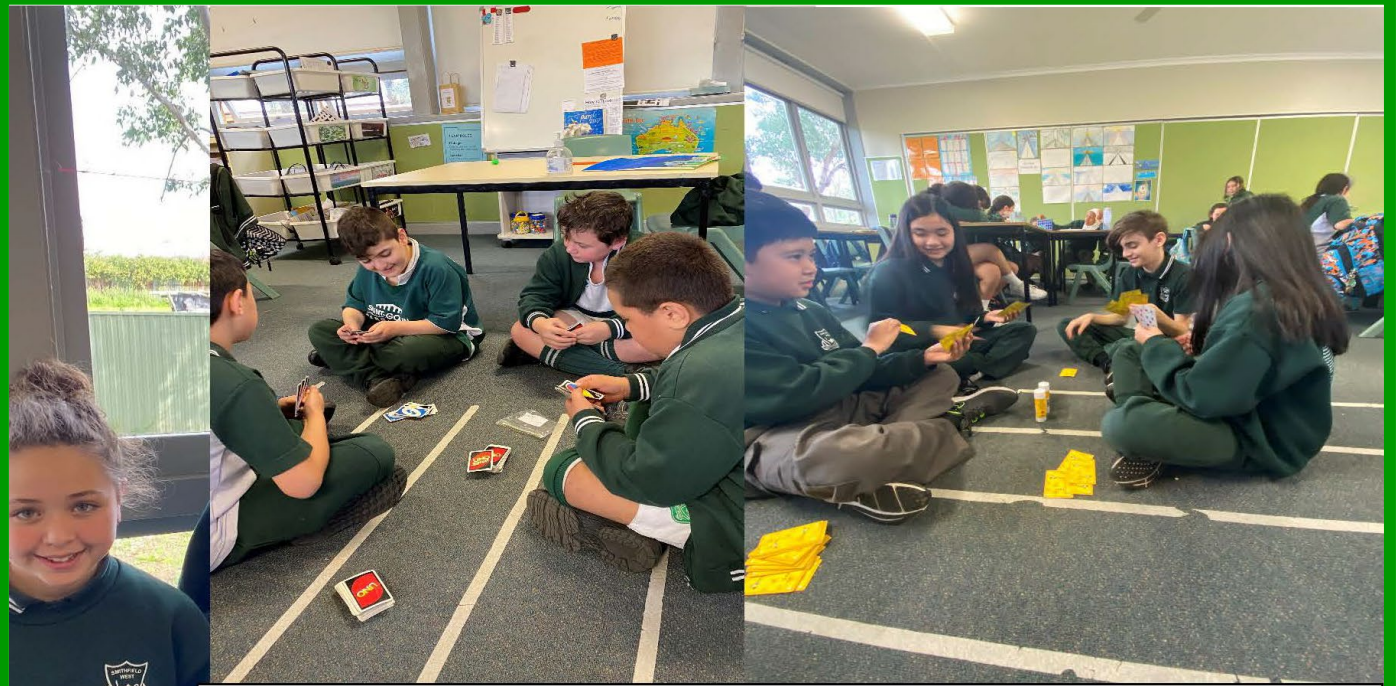
