OPPORTUNITY CLASS PLACEMENT 2025

Applications for Year 5 opportunity class placement in 2025 opened on **Thursday 4 April** and closes on **Monday 20 May 2024**.

Opportunity classes students are one of the ways the NSW Department of Education supports high potential and gifted students. Across NSW there are 86 primary schools with opportunity classes. The nearest to our school are located at Smithfield Public School, St Johns Park Public School and Harrington Street Public School.

Students successfully placed in an opportunity class would transfer to the relevant school and attend the class fulltime in Years 5 and 6.

To gain entry, students must sit a placement test on **Thursday 1 August 2024.** This is usually a very difficult test and parents/carers need to carefully consider if it is suitable for their child.
